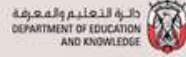

NURSERY

UNIFORM

KG 1 AND KG 2: Girls and Boys:

- Regular school uniform: Navy blue shorts, Light Blue Bush shirts, with side slits.
- P.E. Uniform: Navy blue shorts (the same as the regular school uniform) with Blue T shirts.
- Footwear: Regular school footwear Black shoes with Velcro and grey socks.
- P.E. Uniform footwear: White sport shoes and white socks.

School Blazer, Ties and belts:

- School Blazer: Navy blue with a red stripe along the fold. This should be worn during the cooler months: (October to March.)
- Ties and belts: to be worn on all school days and at all times.
- Winter Wear: School winter jacket or blazer should be worn. Other branded jackets are not allowed.

Grades 1 TO IV: Girls and Boys

- Regular school uniform: Grey, Knee length pleated skirts for girls and shorts for boys with Blue Bush shirts with slits.
- P.E. uniform: House colour T shirt and the 3 coloured sport shorts.

Grades V TO XII: Girls and Boys

- Regular school uniform: Grey, Long pants with blue bush shirts with slits.
- P. E Uniform: Boys House colour T-shirt with 3 coloured sports shorts
- P.E. Uniform: Girls House colour T-shirt with long track pants.

Footwear: From Grades I to XII

- Foot Wear With the Regular School Uniform:
- Boys: Plain black school shoes without shoelaces.
- Girls: Black school shoes (with a strap across) and grey socks.
- PE Footwear for all: White sport shoes and house colored socks.

Grooming: From Grades I to XII

- Boys: Hair should always be well groomed and cutshort. Any haircoloring/highlights is strictly prohibited.
- Girls: Hair should be well groomed. Long hair should be tied back with black band and short hair should not cover the face. Any hair coloring/highlights is strictly prohibited.
- Nails should be trimmed regularly, no additional ear piercing, and free from any colour or enamel.
- Tattoos are also strictly prohibited.

ANTI SMOKING/ ANTI TOBACCO POLICY

In line with Federal Law No. (15) of 2009 on combating smoking , Mayoor Private School aims to provide a safe working and learning environment for both students and staff. The whole school supports the anti-smoking policy which aligns to the other policies of the school such as Health and Safety policy and Behavior Policy.

The Smoke-Free Environment

Smoking is not permitted in any part of the school site including the parking area at any time. Disciplinary Action

The day to day implementation of this policy is the responsibility of the whole school community and everybody has a duty to respond to breaches of the policy. Any person who smokes on the premises will be asked to extinguish the offending item and/or leave the premises. Staff or students who breach the no smoking policy will be advised that this could result in disciplinary action.



ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

In line with the latest ADEK guidelines, parents have to submit the Student Absentee Form if their child is absent on any school day.

The form must be submitted before 8:00 AM on the day of the absence, mentioning the proper reason for absence. Failure to submit the form within the given timeframe will result in your child being marked as Unexcused Absence for that day.

We would like to inform you that we have automated attendance messages in our system for students with 'Unexcused Absences'. Based on the number of unexcused absences that the student has accumulated in attendance, these messages will be sent automatically to parents via SMS and email.

Please note that after 3 days of unexcused absence ADEK will start sending the Absence Notifications at below intervals :

- 3 days of unexcused absence.
- 6 days of unexcused absence.
- 8 days of unexcused absence.

After 10 Days of unexcused absence your case will be automatically referred to ADEK.

ADEK will closely monitor, and further actions may be taken if the absenteeism continues.

Notification of Further Action:

You will receive the message from ADEK indicating that the relevant authority will contact the parent to discuss the consequences of continued unexcused absences of 18-19 days.

Consequences and Final Action:

After 20 days, the message from ADEK will inform parents that the relevant authority will take action and contact them to discuss the consequences of non-compliance with school attendance policies. As per the ADEK attendance policy, leave of more than 21 days in an academic year can lead to retaining students in the same grade for the next academic year.

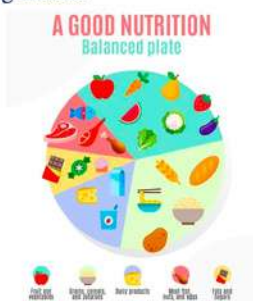

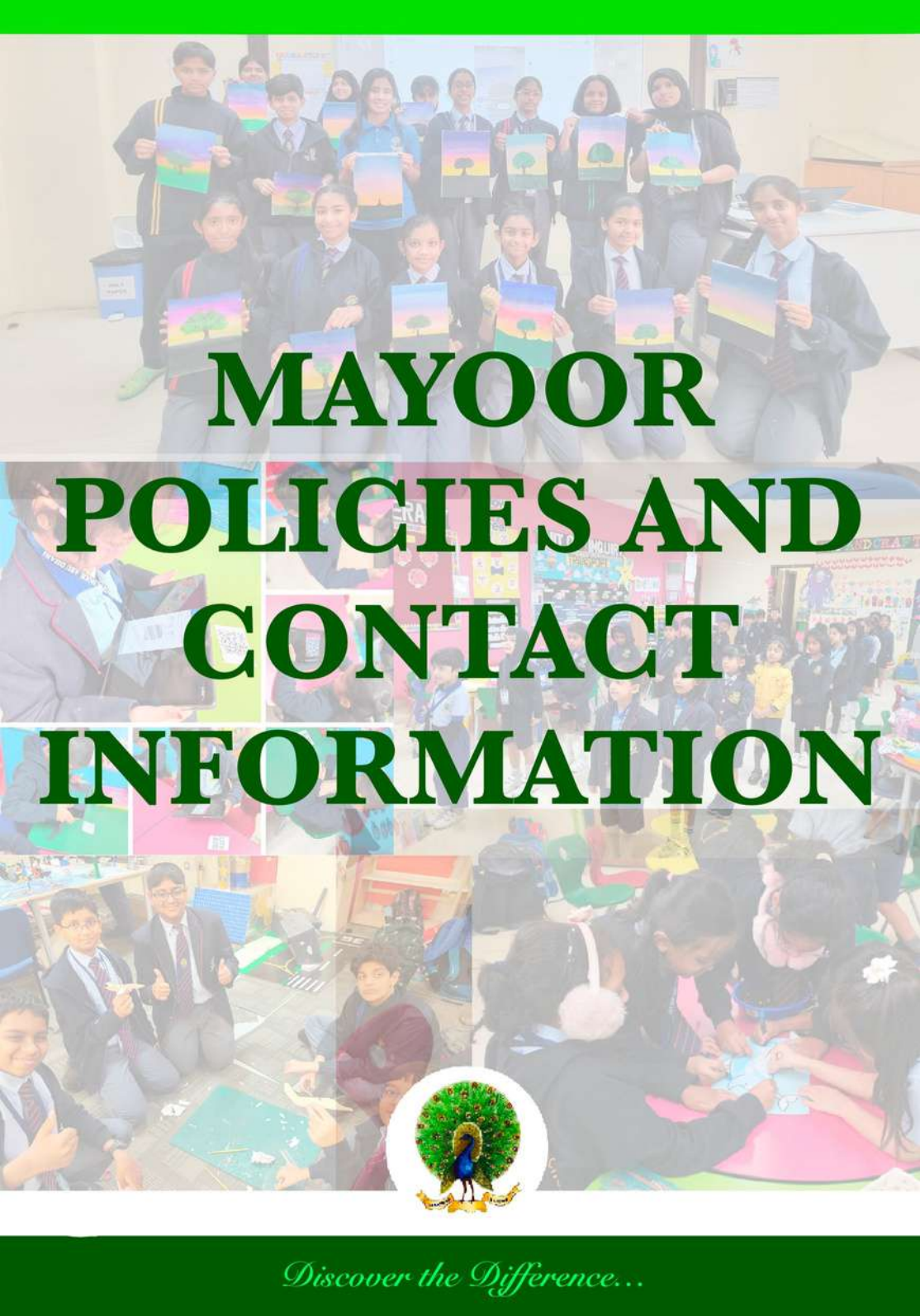

SCHOOL BAG POLICY

Purpose



Mayoor School supports and encourages a safe and healthy lifestyle for all. The weight of the School Bag is part of the physical well being of the students, hence it is the responsibility of all the stakeholders to be actively involved in making sure that the student does not carry a heavy School Bag.

Aims



1. To reduce weight of the School Bag
2. To promote Health and Safety
3. To avoid long term effects of heavy school bags
4. Compliance with ADEK Policy

Guidelines



1. Parents should check the bag of students before they depart for school in the morning and remove all unnecessary things.
2. School will conduct an awareness program at the beginning of every session regarding the weight of the bag and the health hazard of carrying overweight.
3. Teachers will conduct random checks.
4. Home assignments will be flexible by the way of worksheets, soft copies and educational apps like IXL, Raz Kids, etc.
5. Students are advised to buy ergonomic school bags with padded and adjustable straps.
6. The school bag weight should not exceed 20% of the student's body weight.

To ensure that all parties in this relationship are aware of their duties and responsibilities, families are required to read this document carefully and to ratify it only after all queries have been addressed by the school.

Enrollment and Re- enrollment:

- The enrollment, re-enrolment and continuity of my child(ren) for the academic year depends on my agreement with and following of the preceding rules.

Communication with school:

- I will communicate regularly with my child's teachers. I will respond to any phone call or email from any member of the school. My conversation will be polite with any staff in the school.
- If I am asked to attend a meeting at the school regarding my child's education or behavior, I will make every effort to be there on time.
- If I have any concern or questions, I will communicate in a respectful manner with school staff.
- Any change of my/our address, telephone/mobile number, email address shall be immediately notified to the school in writing.
- Any changes to the students particulars shall be notified in writing as soon as possible to the school. I have disclosed all relevant medical and health data about the pupil in the medical record submitted to the school and will keep the school informed of any changes to the information provided therein.
- All communications with the school may be monitored or recorded for quality assurance and training purposes. I am aware that I will receive a communication back from the school, depending on the concern addressed in my email, either in form of a phone call or email within two business days. I will follow the school's communication guidelines and hierarchy.

Attendance:

- I understand that each school day is important, and I will make sure that my child attends school on time, every day. (before 7.45 am.)
- I will not permit my child to be absent from school for unauthorized reasons. I understand the difference between authorized and unauthorized absences.
- I am also aware of the school attendance rules as per ADEK requirements and will abide by it.

Student Behavior and Discipline:

Parents give consent to the following :

- I give consent to implement vaccinations program in school in regulation with health authority.
- I have authorized the administration of emergency medical treatment for my sick/injured child(ren).
